Professor Indra de Soysa hails from a famous Anglican family and his grand uncle the Rt. Revd. Harold de Soysa was the first Sri Lankan to be consecrated Anglican Bishop of Colombo. I consider it a great privilege in welcoming Professor Indra de Soysa as our Chief Guest for our Annual Prize Giving.

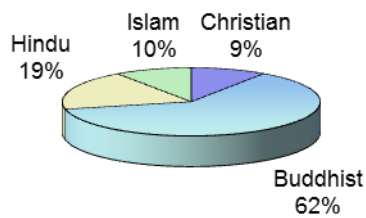

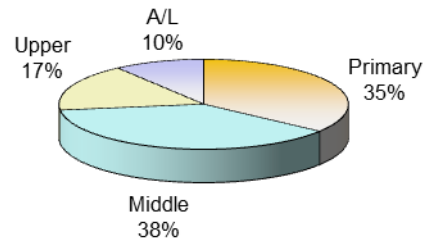

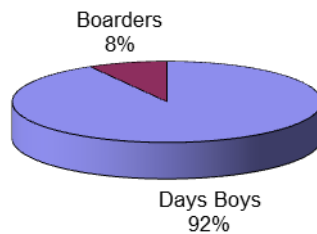
Students by Religion
